## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- 1- All events will be held according to the current rules of CMAS.
- 2- The schedules will be able to be changed according to needs of the organization.
- 3- The protest fee will be 80 €.
- 4- The compressor service is available with DIN and INT adapters.
- 5- Only cylinders with a valid certificated will be filled.
- 6- The competitors themselves are responsible for the proper condition of their equipment.
- 7- The competition will be run in “Embalse Gabriel y Galán”, in the surrounding area of “el anillo” (International Innovation Centre for Outdoor Sports) situated in Zarza de Granadilla (Cáceres) Autonomous Community of Extremadura. ([www.elanillo.org](http://www.elanillo.org)).

### Location:

270 Km from the International Airport of Madrid (Barajas).

### Recommended route by road:

The peninsula where the Ring is located is in two municipal areas, Zarza de Granadilla and Guijo de Granadilla, to a few minutes of the highway of the silver (Autovía de la Plata) and in an environment with magnificent possibilities for the practice of different sports disciplines.

Placed in a strategic point A-5 Madrid - Lisbon, A-6 Seville - Gijón. It is a zone of influence of big centres of population.

**Transfer service from/to Madrid:**

The equipments will be able to request transfer from and towards the Madrid airport (Barajas) . Transfer service will be available from/to Madrid airport twice a day. The organization provides this service under request . The price/person depend on the number of users. The estimated cost is approximately 120 €/person (minimum 10 pax). The definitive price will know once realized the inscription of the equipments.

The deadline to request the transfer will be the 15 th of June.

Service of transfer the days before the competition: 2 transfer/day (1 in the morning and 1 in the evening).

The teams who used the transfer service are requested to specify clearly the hour of arrival and the number of people.
