





# XV Finswimming World Cup 2021 Golden Final (Pool & Open water)

Update August 14th with point 14







# 1. Denomination

The Egyptian Diving and Lifesaving Federation – authorised by CMAS – invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the XV CMAS Finswimming Golden Finale World Cup 2021 organised from 03<sup>rd</sup> till 08<sup>th</sup> November 2021 in Sharm ElShiekh- Egypt.

# 2. Registration process

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming World Cup Rules and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to follow strictly.

### 1. Registration

All registration of athletes for events must be submitted <u>only through electronic way</u>. Application forms can be used only for accommodation, general organisation.

1.9 of rules: Each competitor can take part in a maximum of four (4) individual races, and two (2) relays.

The opening date of registration is Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

#### 2. Registration Tutorial:

For registration, you need an account.

Users who already have registered an account <u>in our system</u>, please re-use your account. In this case, you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials, please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account
- Check your team data. Would you please check if the data is correct and up to date?
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- If the calendar goes to the event you want to register for, click on the "Registration" button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you see the functions to make new entries
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials
- All your registrations go first on a waiting list to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations are approved, and you are notified by email.
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organiser may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

#### 3. Fees of registration

It's not necessary to buy a CMAS licence to participate in World Cup.

#### a. CMAS Fees



For each round or Golden Final, each competitor must pay to participate CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

• 20 € for participation fees by each round (include annually temporary licence).

Please note that the names of relays members must be entered during the registration process based on individual registration even if they swim the only relay. Even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on the place before the beginning of the competition.

These fees are paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card, or bank transfer includes SEPA.

#### b. Miscellaneous

- Fees paid for not performed races are not reimbursed.



- Penalties apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to registration planning.





### d. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

Inscription fees are:

- 20 € for each club;
- 14 per each relay;
- 7 € per each individual distance;
- Fees paid for not performed races are not reimbursed.
- Late enrolments are not accepted because only the CMAS system manages registration during registration planning.
- Only cash payments are accepted upon arrival to the organising committee.

# 3. Participation rules and races

# 1. Races and categories are as follows:

#### SENIOR (Cat. "A") M/W

50 m AP, 100 m IM.,

50 m SF, 100 m SF, 200 m SF, 400 m SF, 800 m SF,

Relay: 4 x 100 m SF, Relay: 4 x 100 m BF mixed.

50 m BF, 100 m BF, 200 m BF, 400 m BF

Open Water: 3 km SF, 3 km BF, 4x1 km BF relay mixed, 4x1 km SF relay mixed

## JUNIOR (Cat. "B") B/G

50 m AP,100 m IM.,

50 m SF, 100 m SF, 200 m SF, 400 m SF, 800 m SF,

Relay: 4 x 100 m SF, Relay: 4 x 100 m BF mixed.

50 BF., 100 m BF, 200 m BF, 400 m BF

Open Water: 3 km SF, 3 km BF, 4x1 km BF relay mixed, 4x1 km SF relay mixed

# 4. Competition place

The competition takes place in Sharm ElShiekh city, South Sinai Governorate, Egypt.

#### Swimming Pool: The International Youth and Sports City

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 25m and ten lanes. The temperature of the water is  $26^{\circ}C$ .

A video-audio control booth in the 'center of swimming pool 'can create and edit video and audio signals and transmit data. During sporting events, the complex can accommodate up to 640 spectators.





## **Long Distance Swimming:** Sharm El Maya bay

Sharm El Maya Beach wraps itself some 1.5km around the inside of a pleasant cove in Southern Sinai.

The beach, wide, sandy, runs from the ferry port in the South to the cliffs of Hadaba to the North.

# 5. Timekeeping system

The pool is equipped with an automatic timing system "ALGE-TIMING" and a full-colour video display.

# 6. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorised to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if the local legislation requires it.





# 7. Classifications

Classifications are based on times registered by the timekeepers, and results are edited according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

There are classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.

- 3.1. <u>Individual</u>: There are, for every distance, four different individual classifications for men, women, Juniors Boys and girls. Swimmers registered by Clubs or Nationals 'Teams are in this classification.
- 3.2. <u>Club</u>: The general classification is made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification are also made for seniors men, seniors women, juniors boys and juniors girls.
- 3.3. <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification is made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification are also made for men, women, juniors boys, juniors girls.
- 3.4. Countries Ranking:
  - 3.5.1. The Countries Ranking is made following the points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
  - 3.5.2.If a National Federation does not enrol its National team. In that case, the best two results by club go to Countries ranking, following the points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, woman, juniors and seniors).

# 8. Prizes

- ➤ **Individual prizes:** medals are given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.
- **Teams prizes:** cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.
- Awarding ceremonies take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.
- > During ceremonies, awarded athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.

# 9. Antidoping

- WADA World Anti-doping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

# 10. Responsibility

The Organising federation, the organising committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.





# 11. Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organiser's judgment. Participating teams get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

Organisers reserve the right to accept and insert an athlete or relay at any time at their discretion, in or outside the official classification, on the specific request of a participating club. Rules in general concerning this competition can be found on the website of CMAS, under the Finswimming Rules.
